LEGACY AWARDS HONORING TRADITION

In 2016-17, the Elks National Foundation allocated \$1 million to fund 250 scholarships for the children and grandchildren of Elks. If you know any Elks children or grandchildren who are high school seniors, encourage them to visit enf.elks.org/leg for more information.

ELIGIBILITY

Any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the Order on or before April 1, 2014, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2014, is eligible to apply. The sponsoring Elk must be a dues-paying member through March 31, 2017. The applicant must be a high school senior or equivalent. If the applicant's parent and grandparent are both Elk members, the applicant must apply through the parent's Elks Lodge.

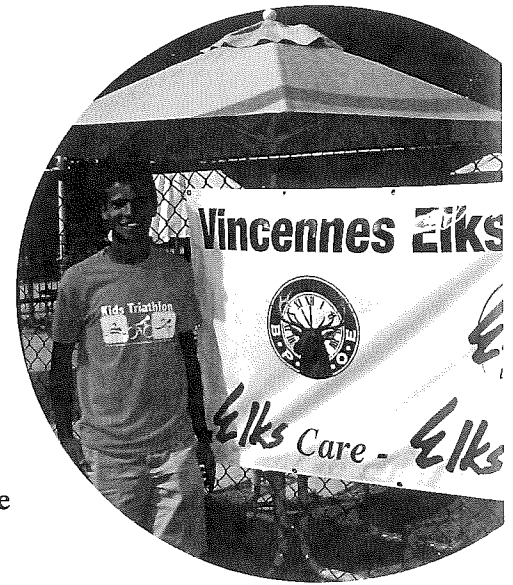
