<b>A- HISTORY</b>	2 YEARS REQUIRED
<b>B- ENGLISH</b>	4 YEARS REQUIRED
<b>C- MATH</b>	3 YEARS REQUIRED (4 RECOMMENDED)
<b>D- LABORATORY SCIENCE</b>	2 YEARS REQUIRED (3 RECOMMENDED)
<i><u>CSU REQUIREMENTS:</u> 1 YEAR OF PHYSICAL AND 1 YEAR OF BIOLOGICAL;</i>	
<i><u>UC REQUIREMENTS:</u> MUST BE AT LEAST TWO OF THE THREE LAB SUBJECTS OF BIOLOGY, CHEMISTRY AND PHYSICS; BOTH MUST BE FROM THE "D" SUBJECT AREA</i>	
<b>E- FOREIGN LANGUAGE</b>	2 YEARS REQUIRED (3 RECOMMENDED)
<b>F- VISUAL/PERFORMING ARTS</b>	1 YEAR REQUIRED
<b>G- COLLEGE PREP ELECTIVE</b>	1 YEAR REQUIRED

- You should organize your colleges in 3 categories:

**Reach**- Chance of getting in are slim

**Match**- When all requirements are fulfilled and match your own.

**Safe**- When you've exceeded the averages
