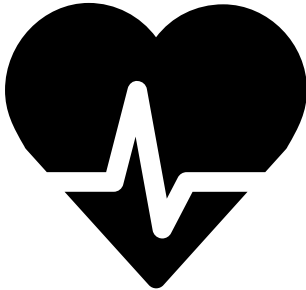


Medical Magnet
