

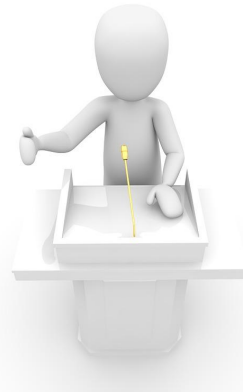

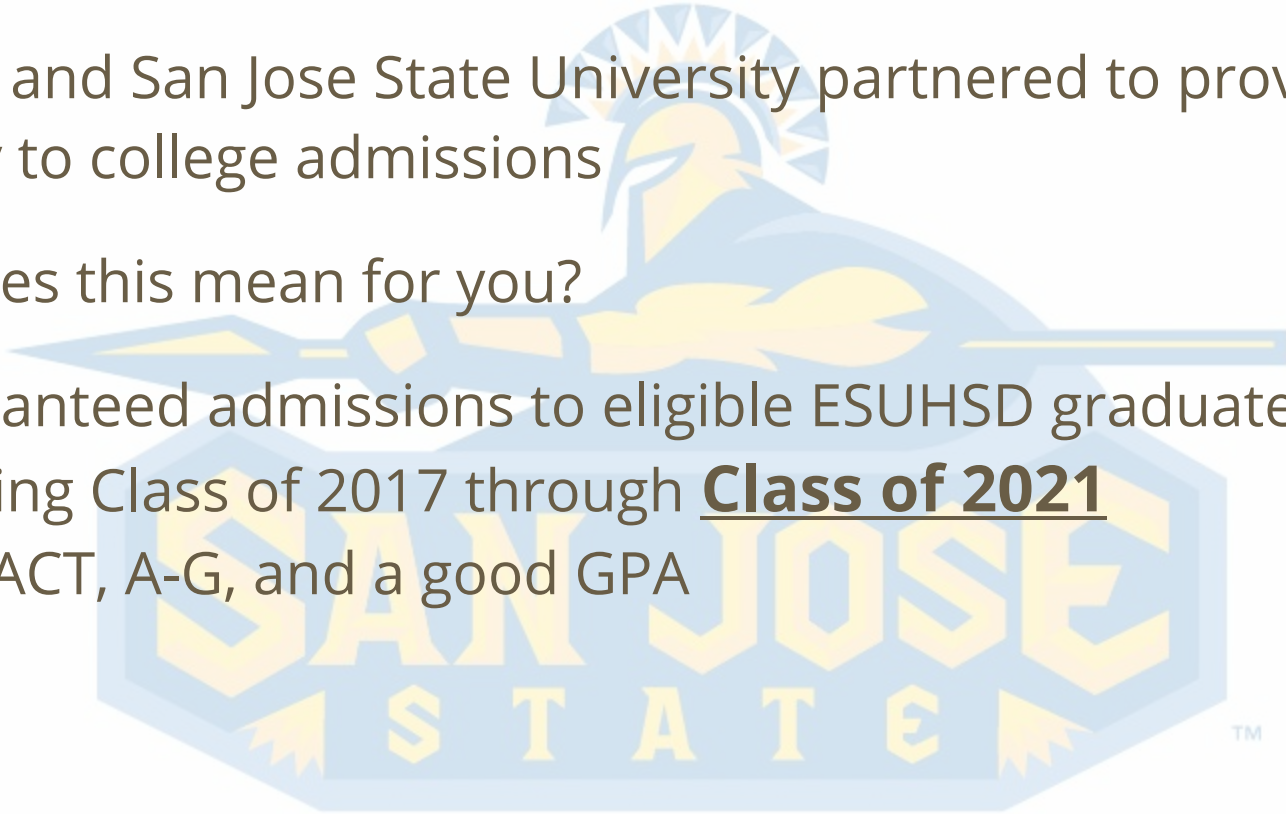
- **Multimedia**- emphasis on Multimedia design and medium of arts

Parent Registration

Registering for your free School Loop account is easy and only takes 1 minute. You will need your child's student ID number to complete the registration form. A student's ID number can typically be found on their student ID card or last report card.

1. Surf to the School Loop website for your child's school and click the **Register Now** button on the login form (it may be necessary to first click the **Login** button on the school's homepage).
2. Click the **Register Now** button.
3. Click the link for **Parent Registration**.
4. Complete the form.
5. Click the **Register** button.
6. You are now registered!

The first time you login, you will be asked to read and acknowledge a User Agreement.
