The Spartan Promise

ESUHSD and San Jose State University partnered to provide a pathway to college admissions

What does this mean for your student?

- Guaranteed admissions to eligible ESUHSD graduates starting with the Class of 2017 through Class of 2021
- Students must meet A-G eligibility requirements
- Take the SAT or ACT
- SAT/ACT score and GPA must meet SJSU eligibility requirement
