

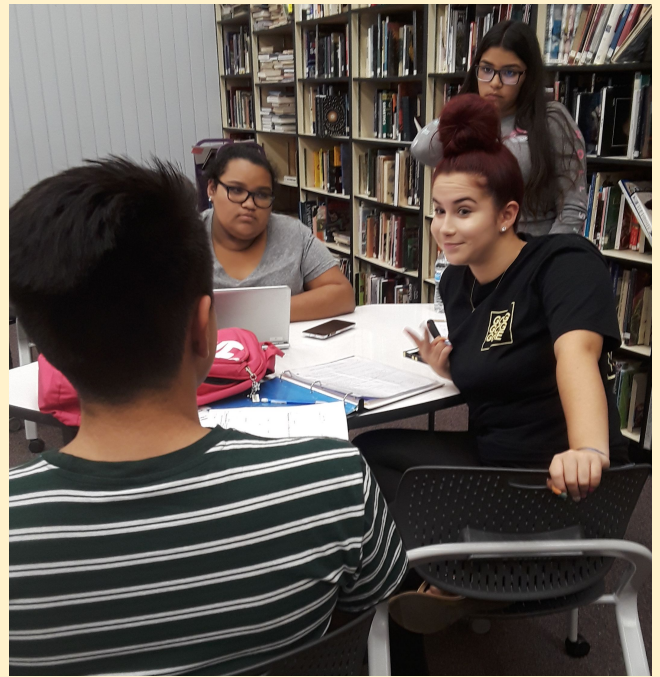

Student Support (during school)

- Ask teacher(s) for help
- Meet with Counselor (college and career questions)
- Meet with Social Worker (stress, time management, emotional)
- Meet with Advisors (social pressures, bullying)
- Check School Loop daily
- Library access during brunch and lunch (every Wed & Thurs)
- Grades every 6 weeks (marking periods)
 - Report cards come home 2 weeks later
- Office Hours 1 Thursday every marking period from 2-3pm.
 - 2 weeks before grades (marking period)
- Free snack in the cafeteria everyday after school (3-4pm)

After School Support (ASSETs Program)

- 10 or more different programs
Monday-Friday
 - Hill Academy Tutoring (Mon, Tues, Wed) from 2:15-4:00pm
 - ELD Newsletter (Monday) from 3:15-4:15pm
 - Weight room (Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs) from 3:15-4:15pm
 - Open Gym (Fri, Sat) from 6-9pm
- Time range 2:15pm-7:00pm
- 5 or more different program offered on Saturdays
- Average 150 students everyday Mon-Fri
- 25,000 student contacts per year
- 5 years for this grant: \$200,000 per year.
