Why is Having a Timeline Important?



College Admissions = meeting requirements & deadlines

- Preparation is the key to a strong college application
- Waiting until senior year is *too* late!



Requirements in a Nutshell

- University of California
 - *a-g* coursework with "C" or better
 - Minimum GPA of 3.0
 - SAT with Essay or ACT w/writing
 - Personal Insight Questions
- California State University
 - *a-g* coursework with "C" or better
 - Minimum GPA of 2.0
 - SAT or ACT
 - Meet the CSU eligibility index







Requirements in a Nutshell

• Private & Independent Schools

- Course requirements vary
- SAT or ACT
 - WITH WRITING may be required
- Letters of recommendation
- College Essay
- Community Colleges
 - Be at least 18 years of age; <u>OR</u>
 - Be a High School graduate







Transition to High School

- Develop good study skills- go to after school tutoring and communicate with their teachers
- Participate in summer programs such as the Summer Math and Science Honors Academy (SMASH) is a free of cost, STEM-intensive 5 week college preparatory program for underrepresented high school students of color.
 - UC Berkeley
 - Stanford
- Encourage student to participate in college field trips!



Sophomore Year

- Extracurricular activities
 - Sports, student clubs, volunteer opportunities, summer programs such as COSMOS from UC Santa Cruz
- Encourage your student(s) to become involved in their community.
- Universities want to know who the student is outside the classroom!



Things to Begin Researching 11th grade

- Admission requirements
- College Entrance Exams
- Financial Aid & Scholarships
- College Visits
- Eligible vs. Competitive
- Start college lists
 - Identify Safety, Target and Reach schools
- DEADLINES!

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Senior year

Application Season starts

- 2nd round of SAT/ACT
- FAFSA or Dream Act Financial Aid app @ Cash for College
- Letter of Recommendations
 - Ask teachers and check deadline
- Apply to UC during the month of November
- CSU between October 1st and November 30th
- Private school deadlines vary usually December or later
