- 0 credits for each “F” (take class again)

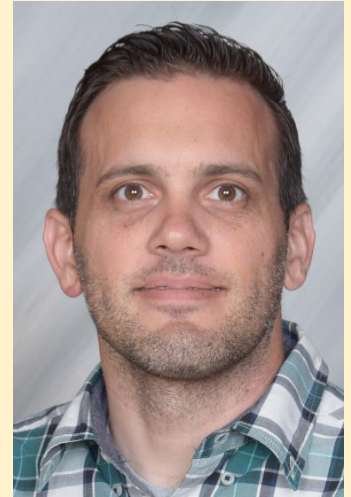
