Attendance-- You Matter!

Falcons are on-time every period, every day.

Students with perfect attendance for a specific week:

- 0 absences
- 0 tardies

Attendance-- You Matter!

Falcons are on-time every period, every day.

Students that are late to class, by period:

- 1 minute warning bell before 2nd, 4th and 6th periods
- 40% of students have 1st period (7am) and end 6th period 2pm)
- 60% of students start 2nd period (8am) and end 7th period (3pm)

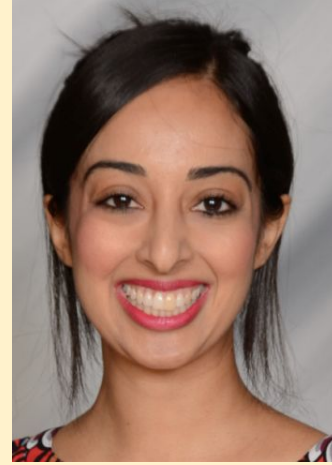

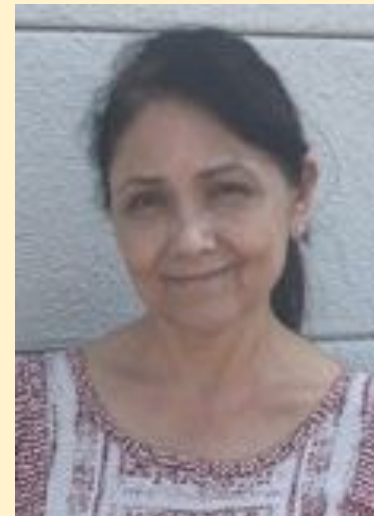
