Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Parking on school property is a privilege, NOT A RIGHT. Students' must observe and abide by all parking lot rules included on this form and as stated in the Student Handbook.
- 2. Only vehicles registered with the school are permitted to be parked on campus. Registered vehicles will be assigned a parking tag. Parking tags must be returned when students graduate, withdraw or have their privileges revoked. A \$5 replacement fine will be assessed to the student's account if the tag is not returned. Students are not permitted to exchange parking permits or give their permit to someone else. This includes early graduates giving their permit to someone upon their graduation.
- 3. Students must park in the Senter Rd. lot near the C-Building and in spaces not marked for STAFF or VISTORS.
- 4. Students are expected to abide all vehicle code and traffic laws. Law enforcement agencies are able and will issue tickets when these applicable laws have been violated while on school property and/or transiting to and from the school.
- 5. ANY VEHICLE NOT REGISTERED WITH THE SCHOOL OR PARKED IN THE WRONG SPACE, IS SUBJECTED TO CITATIONS, LOSS OF PRIVELEDGES, AND/OR ULTIMATELY TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE.
- 6. The enforcement of parking permit privileges will occur between the hours of 6:30 am and 3:00 pm. Students may park in any parking lot after 3pm.
- 7. Loitering will not be allowed in the parking lots. You must vacate your vehicle and the parking lot immediately upon arriving at school, and go to your vehicle and leave campus immediately after your last class.
- 8. Students must exercise extreme caution when driving on school grounds. Maximum speed is 10 mph. Failure to report any motor vehicle accident on school grounds may result in revoke of parking previleges.
- 9. Parking privileges may be temporarily or permanently revoked when a student is referred to advisor/administration for violation of the above rules, school rules, or policies aided through the use of driving to and from school (i.e.; disciplinary issues, dress code, skipping class or school, excessive tardies to first period or second period with late entry, not leaving immediately when having early release, etc.)
- 10. If parking privileges are permanently revoked, the student must reapply the next school year.

Displaying of Parking Permit:

- Place the hang tag on the rear view mirror with the number facing outward.
- Hang tags must be visible through the front windshield.
- Transferring a hang tag to another student will result in the loss of parking privileges.
- Hang tags must be returned to the school upon graduation, withdrawal, or loss of privileges.
- A \$5 replacement fine must be paid for lost or unreturned hang tags.
