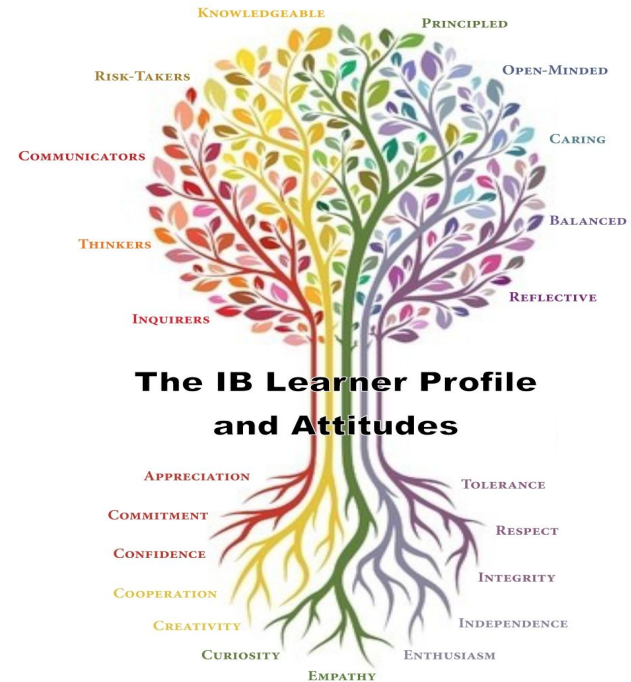

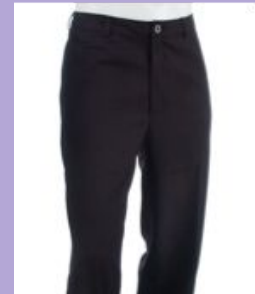

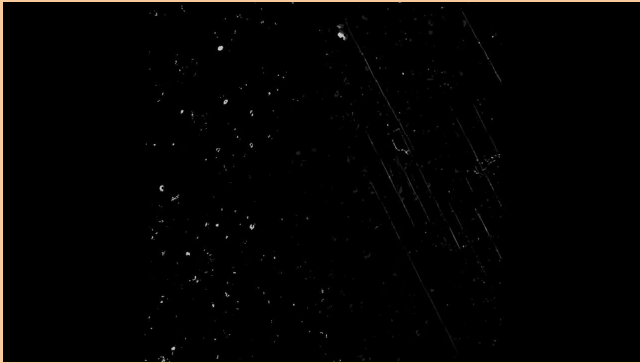

Restroom Pass



- Go only after 15 minutes after class begins
- Only 1 student may go at a time
- Go only when necessary
- Use restroom for its intended purposes only
- Give other Falcons personal space
- Practice personal hygiene
