




**Hurtful language is also known as a *slur*.**

A slur is “an insulting, offensive or degrading remark, often based on an identity group such as race, ethnicity, religion, ethnic, gender/gender identity or sexual orientation.”


A slur is racist, sexist, ageist, ableist homophobic language. A slur is hateful language. This language is very hurtful. Please do not use slurs anywhere.
